The exhibition *Influence and Confluence* is the first joint exhibition of Hopkins House Gallery of Contemporary Art and the Markeim Art Center. The exhibition showcases the work of 10 artists teaching at the three South Jersey four year colleges, Rowan University, Rutgers University/Camden and Richard Stockton State College. These ten professors have selected a current and past student to exhibit with them for a total of 32 artists.

The exhibition will run at Markeim Arts Center from March 1 through April 1, 2011 and at Hopkins House Gallery of Contemporary Art, Camden County Cultural & Heritage Commission on South Park Drive from March 8 through April 9, 2011. Artist receptions will take place at both locations on Sunday, March 27, 2011 from 1:00 p.m. – 4 p.m.
